## Yardages and Cutting

*Note: Label each piece with the letter given in the cutting. The letters are used throughout the instructions. WOF means width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.*

### 1 1/8 yards Green star print, SB20166-820

- 2 strips 4 1/4" x WOF; cut into (14) 4 1/4" squares, then cut twice diagonally to make 56 **A** triangles
- 1 strip 1 1/2" x WOF; cut into (1) 23 1/2" strip and (1) 18 1/2" strip
- 4 strips 1 1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 36 1/2" strips and (2) 32 1/2" strips for first border
- 5 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding

### 3/8 yard Aqua utensil print, SB20165-920

- 2 strips 4 1/4" x WOF; cut into (14) 4 1/4" squares, then cut twice diagonally to make 56 **B** triangles

### 5/8 yard Aqua star print, SB20166-920

- 2 strips 1" x WOF; cut into (2) 23" strips
- 1 strip 2 1/2" x WOF; cut into (1) 17 1/2" strip
- 4 strips 3" x WOF; cut into (2) 42 1/2" strips and (2) 41 1/2" strips for third border

### 3/4 yard White circle print, SB20113-920

- 3 strips 3 7/8" x WOF; cut into (28) 3 7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 56 **C** triangles
- 4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 38 1/2" strips and (2) 36 1/2" strips for second border

### 1 yard Norton panel, SB20160-820

- 4 squares 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" from the corner mouse squares with the motifs centered
- 1 rectangle 16 1/2" wide x about 21 1/2" long from the large center section cutting 1/4" above the aqua edge at the top of the rectangle and 1/4" below the green bottom edge

### 3 1/4 yards Multi-patch print, SB20162-920

- 2 pieces 55" long for backing

## Piecing the Blocks

*Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching.*

1. Sew a green **A** triangle to a blue **B** triangle on 1 short edge to make an **AB** unit. Press seam toward the **B** triangle. Repeat to make 56 **AB** units total.



2. Stitch a white **C** triangle to each **AB** unit on the long edges to make (56) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" block quarter units. Press seams toward the **C** triangles.



3. Join 2 block quarter units to make a row. Press seam to the green **A** side. Repeat to make 28 block rows total.

4. Join 2 block rows to complete a 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" block. Press seam in 1 direction. Repeat to make 14 blocks total.



## Preparing the Large Panel

1. Center and stitch a 1" x 23" aqua star strip to the long sides of the large panel rectangle. Press seams toward the strips. Trim the strip ends even with the edges of the panel rectangle.
2. Sew the 2 1/2" x 17 1/2" aqua star strip to the top of the large panel rectangle. Press seam toward the strip. *Note: There should be no white showing along the top edge. If there is, remove the top aqua strip, trim the top edge a bit and re-stitch the strip.*
3. Trim the pieced rectangle to 17 1/2" x 23 1/2".
4. Stitch the 1 1/2" x 23 1/2" green star strip to the right edge of the pieced rectangle and then the 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" green star strip to the top. Press seams toward the strips to complete the framed panel.



## Completing the Quilt

*Note: Refer to the Exploded Quilt Diagram on the next page throughout the following steps.*

1. Join 3 blocks and add a 6 1/2" panel square to each end to make the top block row. Press seams toward the left end of the row.
2. Join 3 blocks and add a panel square and then a block to the right end to complete the second block row. Press seams toward the right end of the row.
3. Sew the top row to the second row to complete the top section. Press seam to 1 side.
4. Join 4 blocks to make the inner vertical row. Press seams from bottom to top.
5. Join 3 blocks and add the last panel square to the bottom to complete the outer vertical row. Press seams from top to bottom.
6. Sew the inner vertical row to the right edge of the framed panel and add the outer vertical row. Press seams toward the framed panel to complete the bottom section.
7. Stitch the top section to the bottom section to complete the 30 1/2" x 36 1/2" quilt center. Press seam to 1 side.
8. Sew the 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" green star border strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.

9. Sew the 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" white circle border strips to the long sides and the 2 1/2" x 36 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
10. Sew the 3" x 42 1/2" aqua star border strips to the long sides and the 3" x 41 1/2" strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top. Press seams toward the strips.
11. Remove the selvage edges from the 55" backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim the edges to make a 49" x 55" backing piece.
12. Layer, quilt, and bind, using your favorite methods and the green star binding strips, to complete the quilt.
